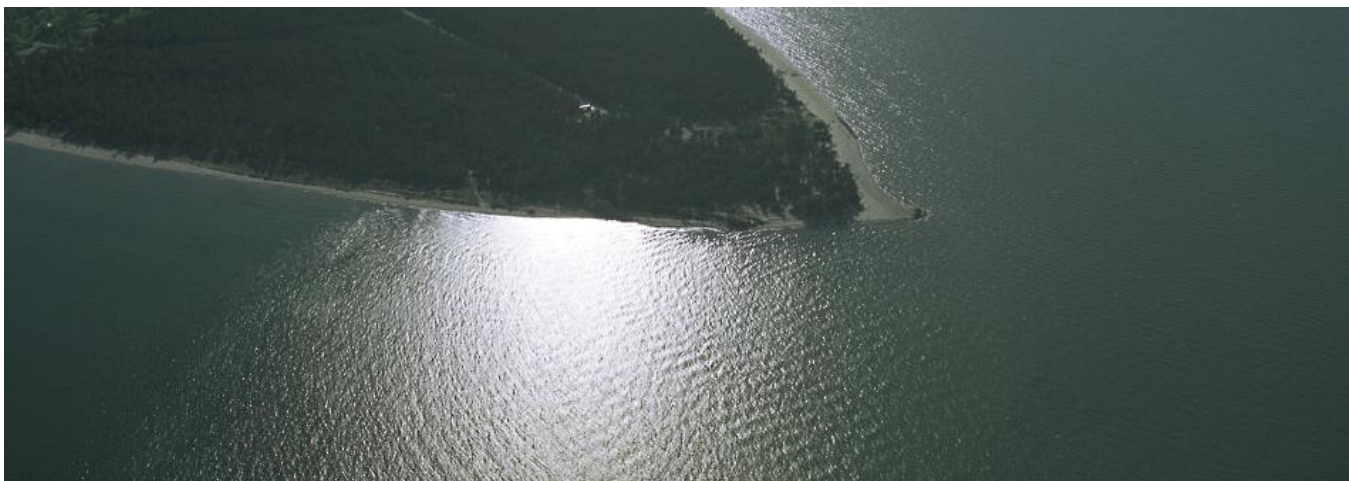
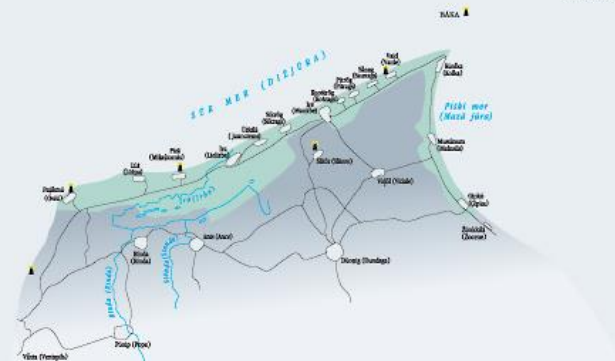

The Livonian Coast is a narrow coastal strip in North Kurzeme from Ķīpa to Ovisi. Here you will find 12 villages with a small number of Livonians descendants who still treasure their cultural monuments.

The Livonians are one of the seven Baltic Sea Finnish nations, Estonians and Finns being their closest kin in this family.

The Livonians are an ancient Indigenous nation in Latvia, the language and culture of which form a significant part of the whole Latvian culture heritage. The Livonian language has existed for over 1500 years. A small number of users have kept it alive. It has a generally recognised linguistic value and as such has been filed in several registers, including the UNESCO register of endangered languages.

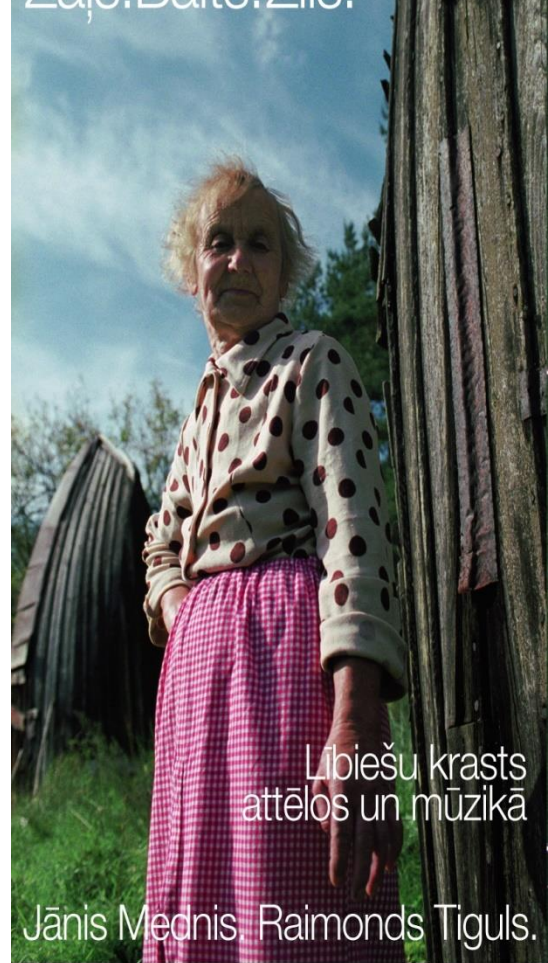

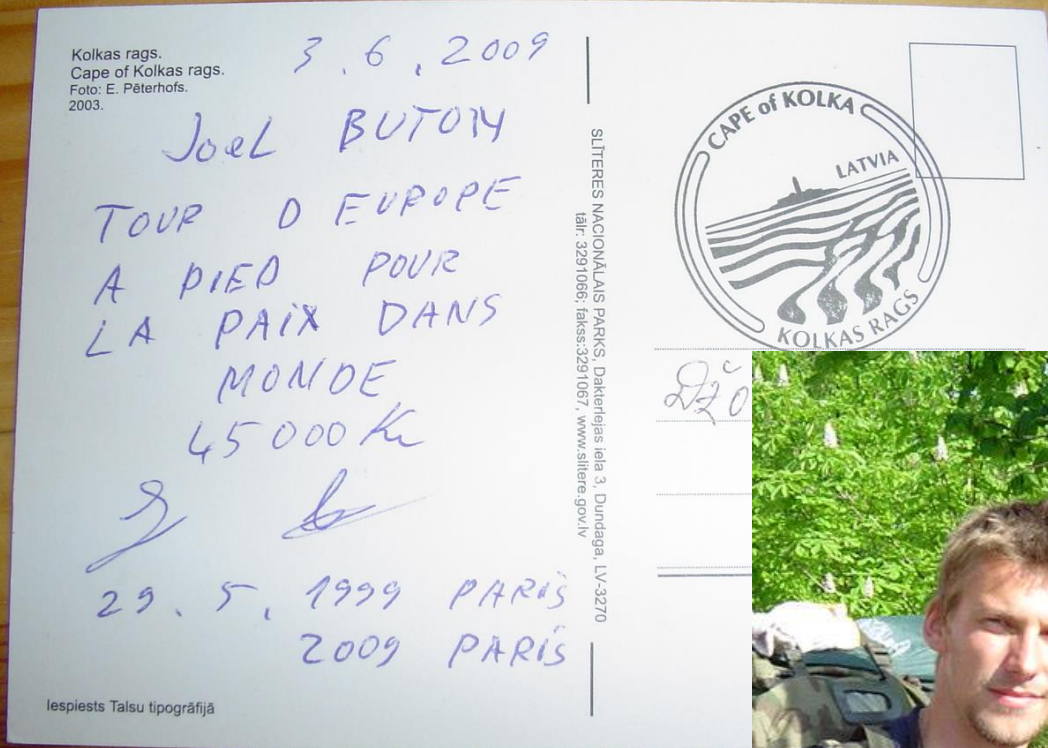
